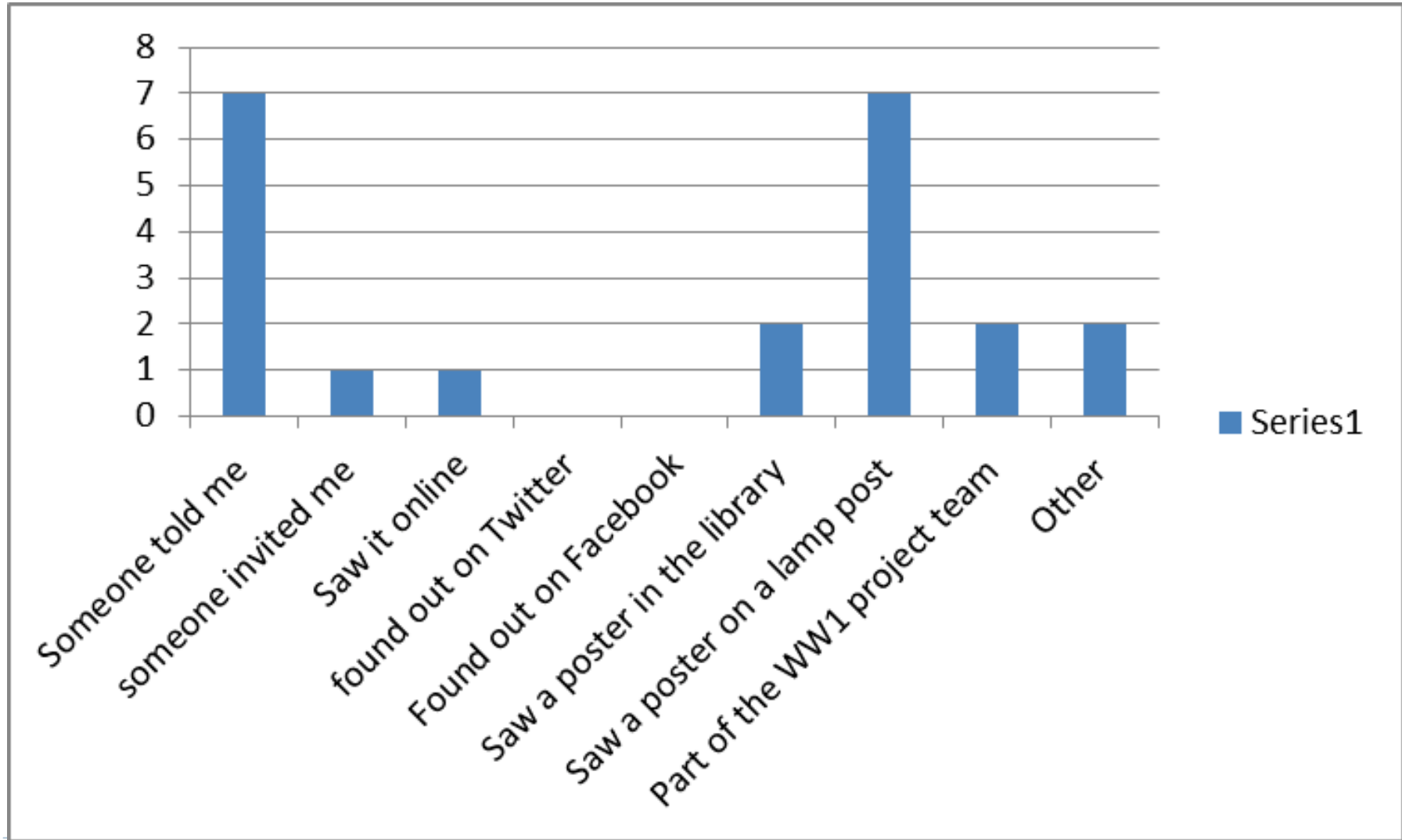


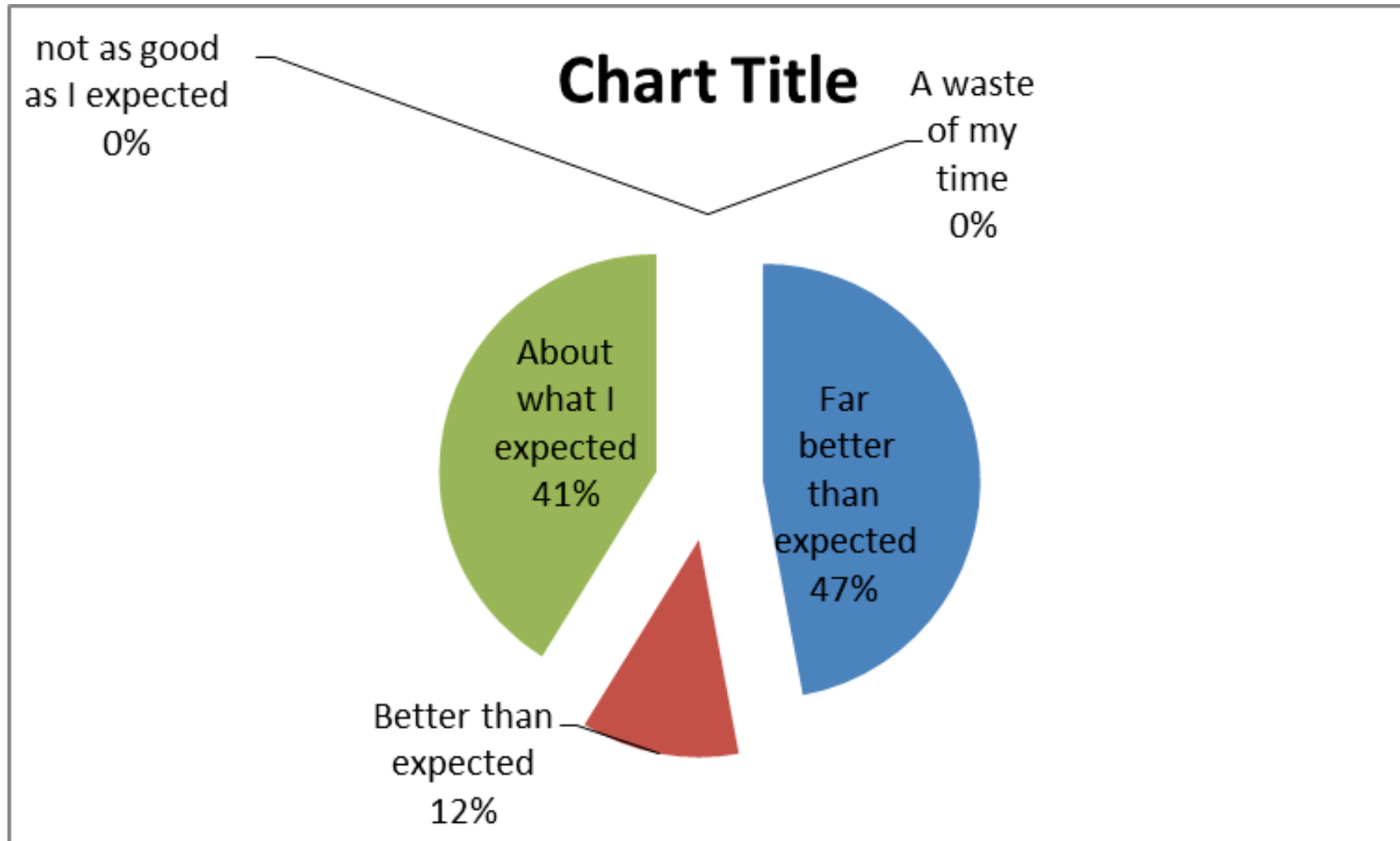
Muffled Bell Peel Event Evaluation
