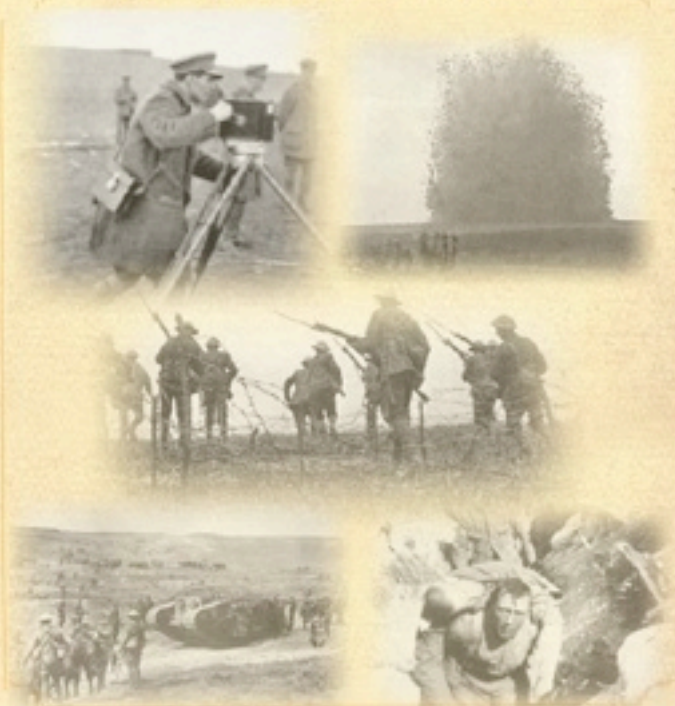

Muston 1st World War Flower Festival - 27th - 29th August Bank Holiday Weekend 2016

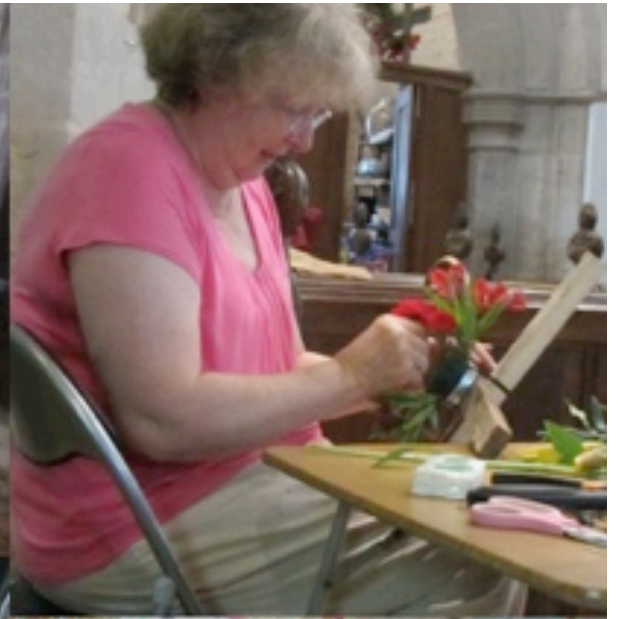
The Muston 1st World War Flower Festival held over the August Bank Holiday was a great success. A team of nine flower arrangers (Jill Chandler, Suszy Davis, Donya Donger, Sue Fenn, Jenny Geraghty, Jo Ives, Lynne Lovell, Marjorie Throssell, and Sue Wadsworth) filled the St John's Church with stunning displays commemorating aspects of home front life and military service. Refreshments were served in The Muston Old School and there was also a display from the Bottesford Parish 1st World War Centenary Project.

A 1st World War Heritage map guided walkers past the homes of eleven men lost from the village.

Over 390 people attended. Many commented on the creative quality and thought provoking impact of the flower arrangements, WW1 displays and Remembrance walk.

Over £1000 was raised toward Church restoration funds. Stewards and other helpers included Peter Chandler, Pru Chandler, Norman Davis, Wendy Hall, John Ives, Sue and David Middleton, Jo and David Payne. 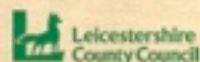

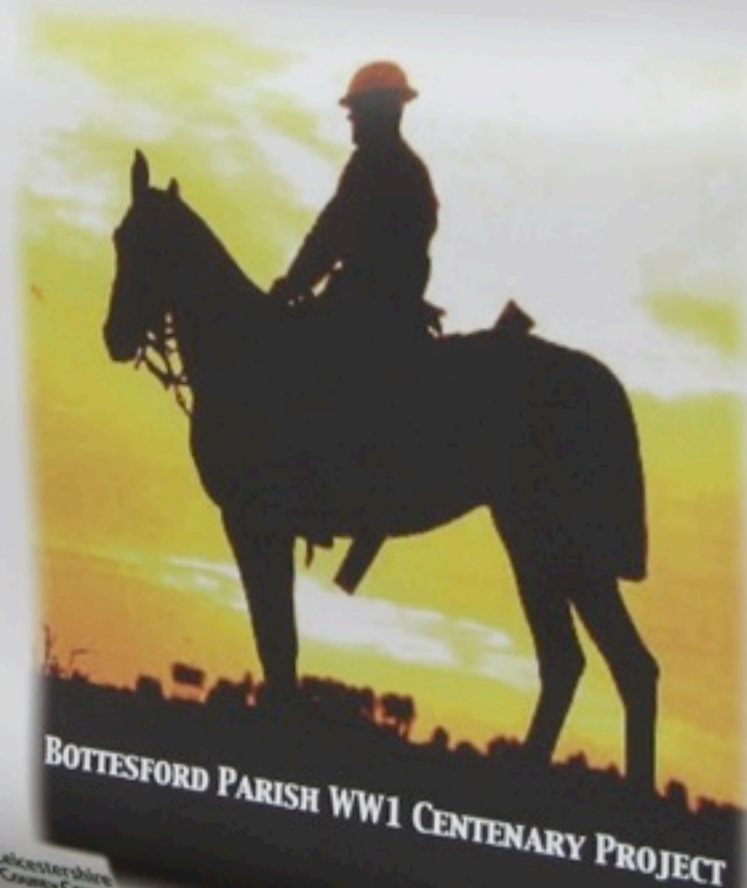
