I give and Bequeath the following:

I wish my wife E.A. Turner to have the sole use of my House and garden and furniture and to receive all dividends from my Investments for her sole use, as long as she lives and remains unmarried. At her death I will and appoint my Executors to sell all my shares of my Investments, and to pay all dues and demands and funeral expenses and a flat Granite stone to cover our graves and the remainder of the proceeds of the sale to be equally divided between my two sons Frederick and Ernest and my two deceased sons wives, Doris Turner and Ethel Turner and my nine grandchildren, I also will that my furniture to be sold at my wifes death and the proceeds to be handed over to my wifes executors to be added to the sale of her investments to be disposed of according to her Will. I also will that my House is to be sold at my Wifes decease and the proceeds be paid to the following institutions after Funeral expenses and death duties and £50 Fifty Pounds to be paid to each Executor for their expenses, and One Hundred Pounds to Church Missionary Society Secretary 6 Salisbury Square London.
